HOW TO GET TO WHITE HART LANE

TRAINS

White Hart Lane mainline station is four minutes walk from the stadium, with regular services that connect to the Victoria Line tube service via Seven Sisters. **Northumberland Park** mainline station is eight minutes walk from the stadium, with regular services that connect to the Victoria line tube service at Tottenham Hale station. Trains run from both White Hart Lane and Northumberland Park stations to Liverpool Street Station and direct trains take about 20 minutes.

BUSES

There are a number of excellent bus services from Seven Sisters running past the stadium entrance (Routes **149, 259, 349** and **W3** all pass the ground).

If you are traveling from inside London, visit journeyplanner.org. If you are traveling from outside London, visit nationalrail.co.uk or check the website prior to each home match for the special National Express Matchday timetables.

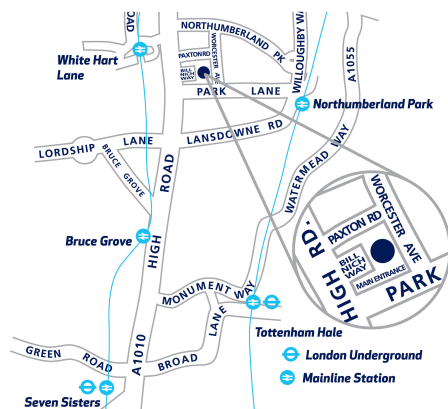
TAXI

A taxi rank is available at Tottenham Hale Station.

BY CAR OR MINIBUS

The stadium is located on Tottenham High Road (A1010) and is one mile south of the A406 (North Circular Road). You can easily join the A406 from the M25 (junction 25), M11 (junction 4) and the A10. The M25 is 15 - 20 minutes from the stadium.

From the City, follow the A10 to Bruce Grove, then straight on to the High Road. Please note



that there is **NO official parking at the ground** and very limited street parking where a residents parking scheme operates on matchdays. Most journeys to the Lane will be quicker and more reliable by public transport. The Controlled Parking Zone for residents operates to an approximate 1 mile radius around the stadium. Vehicles who park within the zone without displaying a valid resident's permit will be subject to a parking violation ticket.

Railway Stations with car parks and direct routes to either White Hart Lane or Northumberland Park stations are Cheshunt, Broxbourne, Enfield Town and Harlow Town.

Fans displaying a valid "blue badge" issued by local authorities to those with mobility restrictions, are able to park within any vacant residents parking bays for a period of 3 hours. Disabled Supporters who are travelling on arranged minibus services should contact the Club in advance for advice on parking.

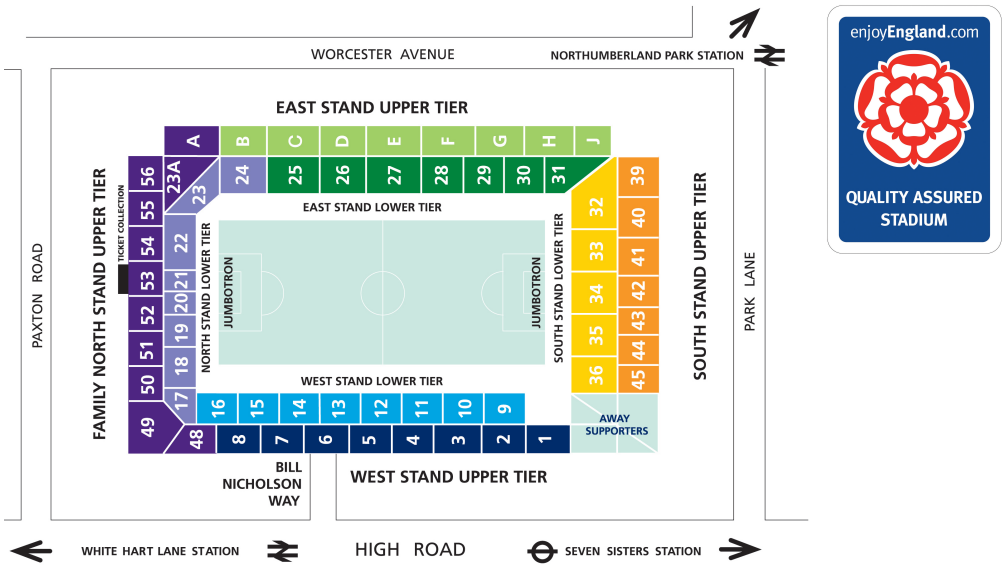
LOCAL AREA

The stadium is situated in the London Borough of Haringey, one of London's most diverse and dynamic areas. If you walk up Tottenham High Road to the stadium from Seven Sisters Station, you will pass restaurants and street vendors selling tasty treats and colourful and exotic food from all corners of the world! This certainly makes the choice of your usual matchday meal a real dilemma! Other local places of interest include **Bruce Castle Park and Museum, Alexandra Palace and Park** and **Wood Green Shopping City** – all well worth a visit!

The nearest ladies public toilets are next to the Bell and Hare. Unfortunately there are no public gentlemen facilities in the immediate local area.

MERCHANDISE

We have a number of matchday stores in and around the the Stadium open on matchdays selling **officially licensed Club merchandise**. The large megastore can be located on the corner of Park Lane and the High Road. Please check tottenhamhotspur.com for opening hours outside of matchdays.

AWAY SUPPORTERS

Visiting supporters are accommodated in **Blocks 37-38 and 46-47** (depending on the ticket allocation the visiting club has elected to use). Entrance to these Blocks can be found on Park Lane. The turnstiles nearest to the junction of the High Road and the Megastore will be in use for away fans. Turnstiles open approximately 90 minutes before kick off and visiting supporters will have access to refreshment bars serving hot and cold food and drinks (alcohol may be restricted for certain games), sanitary facilities and televisions showing Sports News.

CASH MACHINE

The nearest cash machine is located outside the megastore.
